IMPACT OF WAR ON CIVILIANS SINCE 24.2.2022

As of 13 February 2023, it is estimated that
The Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) recorded

- 18,955 civilian casualties
 - a total of 7,199 killed
 - a total of 11,756 injured
- Over 7.8 million have fled Ukraine

UN believes that the actual figures are considerably higher, as the receipt of information from some locations where intense hostilities have been going on has been delayed and many reports are still pending corroboration.

THE UKRAINE CRISIS APPEAL RESETTLEMENT FUND - RESULTS TO DATE



- ✓ \$ 6,000 bereavement support to a young mother and her children to return to Ukraine to bury her husband who died defending Ukraine



- ✓ \$300,000 at \$300pp to date has been paid to 1000 DP's across to support the cost of their BUPA health check required for a 786 visa.
- ✓ \$90,000 approved for additional partial rebates



- ✓ \$ 14,000 subsidy to support the publication of “Books without Borders” for DP children
A program initiated by Ukraine’s First Lady Olena Zelenska



- ✓ \$ 32,000 subsidy for over 100 DP children to attend CYM camp in Sydney and Perth and Plast camp in Melbourne





The AFUO Ukraine Crisis Appeal Resettlement Fund generously contributed \$15 000 to the funding “Стипендія ЮМПЗ,” which allowed 24 participants and 3 leaders who were newly-arrived from Ukraine to enrich our camp with their participation and allow them to enjoy a truly Ukrainian summer in Australian safety.

The scholarships were very successful! All the recipients had a very positive experience at the camp with many approaching the camp komanda and indicating that they were excited to continue participating in Plast events. Particularly exciting were those that had come from interstate, who were planning to return to their temporary home cities and engage with Plast and the wider Ukrainian communities there.

The primary focus being in providing a safe environment when responding to the impact of diverse traumatic experiences linked to forced migration, alongside addressing challenging post-migration difficulties associated with housing, language, education, health, transport, and employment. These challenges are magnified for women and children, so connecting with well-established Ukrainian organisations, in our case a youth organisation provides a familiarity, a sense of belonging and fosters these new connections.
